What topics are covered in the *Operating Theatre Protocols Update* module?

This module provides a review of the ACORN Standards and an opportunity to discuss industry issues relevant to the peri-operative environment.

Learning outcomes

- Reviews changes to the ACORN standards for visitors to the peri-operative environment.
- Explore other relevant changes in policy.
- Discusses topical issues and industry based challenges of the peri-operative environment.
- Revises hand-washing techniques.

Who should participate?

Medical technology industry staff who have previously completed OTP training and are experienced in the peri-operative environment, or who are registered surgical nurses should attend this training. Modules 3.1, 3.4, 3.7 and 3.8 are recommended as complementary training for this module. Module 3.5 is the recommended prerequisite.

How much does it cost?
